Elaboration of NaCCRA purposes

The general purpose of the organization shall be educational and civic in the belief that understanding and service are the best form of advocacy. It is intended to:

- a. Enhance the financial security and quality of life of continuing care retirement community (CCRC) residents throughout the United States, and
- b. Foster and encourage the growth of the continuum of care concept as a desirable program, and
- c. Serve as an information source for the State Associations, Resident Associations, NaCCRA Chapters and Individual Members, and
- d. Provide educational resources to allow Members to participate more fully and capably in the management and direction of the communities in which they live, and
- e. Promote the development of standards for regulatory legislation whether at the state or federal level, and
- f. Provide a public forum and other opportunities for CCRC residents and persons interested in the welfare of the older Americans to interact with each other nationally and to share ideas for the advancement of vitality and well-being throughout life.
